

**DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DBE) &
AIRPORT CONCESSION DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (ACDBE)
PUBLIC NOTICE**

DBE & ACDBE NOTICE - The Key West International Airport and the Florida Keys Marathon Airport have established Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) programs and Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) programs in accordance with regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT), 49 CFR Part 26 and 23; respectively.

The following are the proposed goals for these programs for the FAA Fiscal Years 2017 – 2019:

- Key West International Airport: DBE goal of 9.1%, ACDBE goal of 0.02% for car rental concessions, and ACDBE goal of 1.16% for non-rental car concessions;
- Florida Keys Marathon Airport: DBE goal of 4.8%; ACDBE goal of 0.02% for car rental concessions, and no goal for non-rental car concessions.

The proposed goal methodologies are available for public inspection at the respective Airport Administration Offices during normal business hours. The proposed goal methodologies are also available on the Airport's website (<http://eyw.com/page/Disadvantaged-Business-Enterprise>). The public inspection period is thirty (30) days beginning June 23, 2017.
